Our mission is simple: to produce Rochester's only free and open Hacker Conference. We've successfully done this for the last four years – teaching the community about threats to privacy, supporting Rochester's hacker scene, and fostering lasting relationships between security professionals.

## Hackers in Rochester?

We don't shy away from using the word hacker; we celebrate it. BSidesROC is a hacker conference in the most positive sense of the word possible – similar in nature to the annual DEF CON hacker conference in Las Vegas. While the "hackers" are often portrayed negatively in the media, we embrace the original meaning of the word: our hackers are people who innovate, learn, and stretch technology to its limits. They then share their experience with the rest of the world, and help secure the public by providing research and insight into security problems and explaining privacy concerns.

## What's a Security B-Sides?

BSidesROC, is one of many security conferences held worldwide under the Security B-Sides banner. The goal of B-Sides events is different than standard, run-of-the-mill conferences. We focus on creating opportunities for individuals to both participate in a collaborative atmosphere. Unlike other conferences where speakers just talk blindly to a room full of people – we ensure that our participants – presenters and attendees alike – know that open dialogue during the talks is encouraged. Rather than focusing on the talks, B-Sides events focus on the people, providing space for ad-hoc conversation. We provide a number of events – from classic hacker "capture the flag" games to cryptographic challenges and puzzles. The goal is to get people out of listening mode, and get them plugged in to the community.

## Speaking of Community...

One of the underlying goals of BSidesROC (besides throwing a good conference), is to support the growth of local businesses, professionals, and students: our presentations help raise awareness locally about security topics, our capture-the-flag competition helps show off the skills of talented individuals, and our sponsors are provided prominent mention throughout the conference in between talks, on printed materials, on T-Shirts, and on the BSidesROC website.



We've seen the rewards of these efforts recently as local news agencies have reached out to BSidesROC staff to provide insight and commentary on current privacy threats that affect consumers.

## BSidesROC the Organization

BSidesROC is a 100% volunteer run group, not one of our staff is paid – though we have established an LLC to ensure that the business side of running a special event is properly handled. The volunteers that invest their time in running BSidesROC understand that our goal is to throw a good hacker conference, not make money. The combination of sponsors who “get it”, with our excellent volunteers, enables us to keep coming back year after year.

Our operating costs are miniscule: we raise just enough money in sponsorship donations each year to pay for the venue, the food, badges, insurance, and the other costs that come with running the con.
